Veronica is a caring, sweet young lady. She is 18 years old and is in the 11th grade. In her free time, she loves to bake fancy desserts and to spend time with friends and family. After high school, Veronica would like to pursue a career in Physiology or Pedagogy, because she wants people to have a better future. Veronica has grown up the past six years within the FGCI ministry in the Home of the Good Shepherd Christian foster home. To see this young lady come to know the Lord through baptism... there truly is no greater joy or reward in ministry. Veronica was baptized on September 20, 2020.

Maleesha asked Veronica 5 different questions regarding her decision, and here are Veronica's responses:

1. Why did you decide to get baptized? Veronica writes, "I decided to get baptized because I believe in God. I believe after death, there is life up in heaven. I want to be in the presence of God in heaven where it is good and beautiful; not like in hell. I have chosen to follow God, because I do not want to be like my biological parents who did not raise me with a good past.
